**MARKET PREVIEW**

**US:** U.S. stocks ticked up on Wednesday erasing sharp losses from earlier in the session, amid a continued global bond yield rout and further indications that the Federal Reserve will keep interest rates on hold due to ongoing Brexit concerns

**Asia:** Asian stocks swung between gains and losses, after two days of declines, as investors weighed the prospects for global growth and the timing for higher U.S. interest rates

**India:** Indian stocks declined, led by two-wheeler makers and utilities, as some investors judged the benchmark index's advance to an eight-month high was overdone. The Sensex slid 0.4 % at the close in Mumbai, ending a six-day, 3.3 % climb. **Market is expected to open with gap up and likely to witness positive move during the day.**

**Economy:** Bank of Japan Governor Haruhiko Kuroda said the central bank is ready to expand monetary stimulus further if needed to achieve its 2% inflation target, but made no mention of the Brexit vote that has spread turmoil in financial markets.

The U.S. SEC has approved plans by the NYSE to speed up and smooth early morning trading in times of market stress. The SEC said the NYSE could allow stocks to open for trading on particularly volatile days, even in the absence of clear price disclosure that is normally required before trading opens.

Brazil will likely raise taxes lower next year to reduce a key budget deficit to between 150 and 160 billion reais (\$48.06 billion)

US trade gap increased 10.1% to \$41.1 bn; April's trade deficit was unrevised at \$37.4 bn. The US trade deficit widened more than expected in May as rising oil prices helped to push up the import bill while exports were constrained by the lingering effects of a strong dollar.

**Commodities:** U.S. crude oil prices rebounded in Asia on Thursday as investors weighed industry data that showed stocks fell more than expected and massive oversupply at the global level.

Gold gained in Asia on Thursday as minutes from the Federal Reserve's June board meeting suggested any move to raise interest rates this year will be set against global economic headwinds.

**Currency:** The dollar moved back higher against the other major currencies on Wednesday, after the release of strong U.S. service sector activity data and as concerns over the global ramifications of the Brexit vote continued to support demand for safer assets.

### Petronet LNG plans Rs 5K cr terminal in Bangladesh

India's biggest gas importer Petronet LNG Ltd has plans to set up a Rs 5,000 crore LNG import terminal at Kutubdia islands in Bangladesh as it looks to build terminals to feed demand in neighbouring countries. Petronet have proposed to construct a 5 million tons per annum capacity liquefied natural gas (LNG) import terminal at Kutubdia islands off Cox's Bazar," Petronet Managing Director & CEO Prabhat Singh told PTI. ### Aurobindo eyes Teva's product sale in Europe

Aurobindo Pharma Limited is likely to be the second Hyderabad-based company actively looking at acquiring the 'overlapping products' from Israeli generics drug major Teva, this time in Europe. ### Claris get nod for Tobramycin injection in the US

Ahmedabad-based sterile injectables company Claris Lifesciences Limited along with its subsidiaries today announced that Claris has received the abbreviated new drug application (ANDA) approval for Tobramycin injection in the US. Tobramycin Injection is an anti-infective used to treat certain serious infections that are caused by bacteria such as meningitis and other infections of the blood, abdomen (stomach area), lungs, skin, bones, joints, and urinary tract. ### Restructuring two-wheeler business, 250 workers given VRS:

M&M is restructuring its two-wheeler business after the division failed to meet its expectations and has given voluntary retirement scheme to 250 workers as part of the process. "It is one vertical which has not met expectations last year. We are currently in the process of deciding the way forward for our two-wheeler business," Mahindra & Mahindra Executive Director Pawan Goenka told reporters here. (FE)

### IOC deal spoils OVL's Vankor deal negotiations

OIL-IOC-BCPL combine's \$2.02 billion deal to acquire 23.9% stake in Russia's Vankor oilfield has spoilt ONGC Videsh Ltd's chance of negotiating down the price for additional 11% it is buying in the same field. OVL, the overseas arm of state-owned Oil and Natural Gas Corp (ONGC), had in September last year bought 15 per cent stake in Russia's second biggest oilfield of Vankor for \$1.268 billion. (FE)

#### Government defers implementation of ICDS by an year to 2017-18 assessment year

The government has deferred the implementation of Income Computation and Disclosure Standards (ICDS) by an year to 2017-18 assessment year, bowing to industry demand to give it more time for preparation. (ET)

#### Maharashtra plans \$10 billion infra fund

In what Maharashtra claims will be a game changer, the state is planning a whopping \$10-billion fund, which would be used for building infrastructure in rural areas of the state and specifically in Mumbai. (ET)

#### Confident of passing GST Bill in Monsoon Session: MoS for finance Santosh Gangwar and Arjun Ram Meghwal

Newly appointed ministers of state for finance Santosh Gangwar and Arjun Ram Meghwal said the government is confident of getting the Goods & Services Tax (GST) bill passed in the upcoming monsoon session. (ET)

#### Pulse output may go up to 20 million tonnes this crop year: Ram Vilas Paswan

Pulse production could increase by 18 per cent to 20 million tonnes this crop year on better monsoon which would help bring down retail prices, Food Minister Ram Vilas Paswan today said. Paswan said the Centre is committed to control retail prices of pulses and has taken several steps to boost domestic supply and curb rising rates, but rued that states are not taking enough measures. (ET)

#### Farmers asked to sow water-guzzling crops

India's weather office has asked states to advise farmers to opt for late sown and water-guzzling crops since the south-west monsoon is expected to be surplus this year and withdraw by October instead of mid-September. The food ministry has also asked all states to keep ample stock of food grain in case of a flood-like situation. (ET)

**Sanofi signs research deal for a Zika vaccine with Pentagon**

The co has struck a R&D agreement with the Walter Reed Army Institute of Research in the U.S. WRAIR, a biomedical research facility administered by the U.S. Dept of Defense, would transfer a Zika purified inactivated virus vaccine technology to Sanofi Pasteur, the co's vaccines division. (ET)

**Melrose to buy residential products maker Nortek for \$1.44 bn**

Engineering turnaround specialist Melrose agreed to buy Nortek Inc in a cash deal valuing the U.S.-based residential products maker at \$1.436 bn. The offer of \$86 per Nortek share represents a premium of about 38% to Nortek's close on Tuesday. (WSJ)

**Volkswagen recalls 5,900 gas-powered models worldwide**

The recall is due to potential risks that corrosion might cause the gas tank to burst and thus create a considerable injury risk. VW said customers with vehicles affected by this move should run the cars with gasoline until they have been refitted. (ET)

**Apple drops to fifth in China's mobile market as local brands rise**

Apple Inc is losing ground in its biggest overseas market in a fresh blow for the technology giant. iPhones made up 10.8% of devices sold in May, down from 12% a year earlier. By comparison, Chinese vendor Huawei Technologies increased its lead with 17.3%. (ET)

**Verizon to Raise Monthly Wireless Plans by up to \$10 a Month**

The co is raising prices for its wireless service, a sign that aggressive discounting by smaller rivals hasn't dented the ability of the biggest U.S. players to keep customers and lift monthly bills. US's largest carrier by subscribers will increase prices by \$5 or \$10 a month, depending on the plan size. (WSJ)

**Danone in talks to buy WhiteWave Foods to revitalize growth**

The deal would boost Danone's pursuit of affluent consumers by adding WhiteWave's popular healthy food offerings to its portfolio, as it struggles with setbacks in more challenging markets such as Brazil and Russia. (Reuters)
