MARKET PREVIEW

US: U.S. stocks were relatively flat on Wednesday, as the Dow Jones Industrial Average and S&P 500 Composite index both pared gains after hitting fresh all-time highs, amid crashing oil prices and a weaker dollar.

Asia: Asian markets appeared to have lost some of its momentum on Thursday, trading mixed at the open, after US stocks closed near the flatline but still managed to make it further into record territory.

India: Markets finished the session on a tepid note as participants turned cautious after sharp gains in the previous sessions and ahead of the June quarter earnings of IT majors TCS and Infosys this week. The S&P BSE Sensex gained 7 points to end at 28,815 and Nifty50 dipped 2 points to close at 8,520. In the broader market, both the BSE Midcap and Smallcap indices, down nearly 1%, underperformed the front-liners.

Market is expected to open on flattish note and likely to witness range bound trading session.

Economy: The U.S. economy continued to expand from mid-May through the end of June but there was little indication that inflation would surge any time soon, the Federal Reserve said on Wednesday.

The IMF on Wednesday forecast Russia's economy would shrink by 1.2 percent in 2016, an improvement on its previous forecast in May which predicted a 1.5 percent contraction.

The Bank of England is set to cut interest rates for the first time in more than seven years as it tries to cushion the economy from the shock decision by voters to pull Britain out of the European Union.

The Bank of Canada (BoC) decided to keep its benchmark interest rate on hold in July, while expecting inflation to hit target and growth in the Canadian economy to accelerate next year, it announced on Wednesday.

Commodities: Crude futures fell sharply on Wednesday, retreating back near two-month lows, as investors shrugged off a modest draw in U.S. oil stockpiles placing a greater focus on the sharpest build in distillate fuel inventories in six months.

Gold edged higher in Asia with investors keeping a sharp eye on central bank moves with the Bank of England set to announce its latest moves Thursday and questions swirling whether the Bank of Japan may take new easing steps.

Currency: The U.S. dollar moved lower against its Canadian counterpart on Wednesday, after the Bank of Canada left interest rates unchanged, although declining oil prices appeared to limit the Canadian currency's gains.

Godrej Industries plans Rs 600 cr investment in 2 group firms

Godrej Industries plans to invest Rs 600 crore in its two group companies - Godrej Properties and Godrej Agrovet - through subscription/purchase of shares. (ET)

Max Healthcare to acquire remaining 49% stake in Saket City Hospital for Rs 300 crore

Max Healthcare is set to acquire the remaining 49% stake in the erstwhile Saket City Hospital in South Delhi from BK Modi Group firm Smart Health City Pte Ltd for a little over Rs 300 crore. (ET)

Essar to invest up to Rs 1,000 crore by FY18 in West Bengal

Essar Oil is readying itself to start production of shale gas at its Ranigunj coal bed methane block. The plan is to start production as soon as possible after guidelines for such production processes are notified. (ET)

HCC first to get debt relief under new RBI scheme

Hindustan Construction Company has become the first firm to get relief under the Reserve Bank of India's Scheme for Sustainable Structuring of Stressed Assets (S4A) for its Rs 4,900-crore debt. According to the scheme, banks can convert half the company's loans into equity/redeemable optionally convertible preference shares or optionally convertible debentures in the next 90 days. (BS)

Emami Agro plans Rs 685-crore investment

Emami Agrotech has lined up an investment outlay of Rs 685 cr to raise prodn, while roping in a UK-expert help in the endeavor, to double its market share in the edible oil segment. (BS)

Mining lease of Pottangi bauxite mines granted to NALCO

NALCO has been granted Pottangi Bauxite Mines, in Koraput district of Odisha, where the company's 22,75,000-tonne lumina refinery is located. NALCO has been granted the mining lease of Pottangi with an area covering 1,738 hectares for a period of 50 years, a company said. (ET)

Hinduja Ventures to hike stake in IMCL

Hinduja Ventures announced that the BOD resolved to purchase 43,03,000 equity shares (constituting 5.82% of the paid up equity share capital of IMCL) of Rs 10 each at a premium of Rs 456 per share and 7,03,60,000 preference shares (constituting 26.02% of the paid up preference capital of IMCL) of Rs 10 each at par of IMCL, a subsidiary of the Company from Grand Investgrade, a wholly owned subsidiary of the Company. (BS)

Government to sell 15 per cent share of NBCC

The government plans to sell a 15 percent stake in state owned NBCC (India) Ltd through an offer for sale (OFS), expecting to raise about Rs 1,700 crore. CCEA cleared the proposal. (ET)

Indian Hotels sells Taj Boston for Rs 839 crore

Tata Group hospitality major Indian Hotels Company BSE -0.46%, which runs Taj Group of hotels, has completed sale of Taj Boston hotel for \$125 million (about Rs 839 crore) and will use the proceeds mainly to pare debt. (ET)

Majority stake in Hexaware Technologies on sale; Baring, PCCW talk terms

Baring Private Equity Asia is in exclusive talks with Hong Kong-based PCCW to sell a majority stake in Hexaware Technologies, two investment bankers with direct knowledge of the developments told. The talks are currently understood to be focused around valuations with Baring seeking a minimum 15% premium over the IT player's current market price. (FE)

COAI wants Trai to adopt flat 1% annual spectrum usage charge, says there are no legal hurdles

A grouping of GSM telcos wants the govt to adopt a flat 1% annual SUC, saying there are no legal hurdles in implementing this rate, and backed the telecom regulator's view that a uniform levy was the best option because it would be difficult to segregate revenue from different bands of airwaves. (ET)

Consumer, SME loan market to reach \$3 trillion in 10 years

With the government taking various initiatives for hassle-free and cashless financial transactions, the consumer and SME loan market is expected to grow to \$3,020 billion over the next decade, says a Credit Suisse report. (ET)

Government taking measures to control prices of pulses

With pulses still ruling as high as Rs 200 per kg, the govt said it is taking several measures to boost domestic output & imports, besides taking action against hoarders to control rates. (ET)

India imposes anti-dumping duty on Chinese refrigerant

India has slapped anti-dumping duties on import of a refrigerant from China saying it hurt domestic producers. The government imposed an anti-dumping duty of \$ 1.22 per kilogram on import of '1,1,1,2 - Tetrafluoroethane' or 'R-134a' from China for a period of five years till July 10, 2021, said by the Revenue Department. (ET)

Chinese corporation to bid for Rs 40,000 crore highway contract in India

China Railway Construction Corporation, has evinced interest in bidding for Rs 35,000-40,000 crore worth of highway contracts in India. (ET)

NABARD takes baby steps to revive water table in Punjab, Haryana

Waking upto the challenges being posed by the depleting water levels in agrarian states of Punjab and Haryana, resulting in high input costs of crops. With water level going as deep as 200 meter in some pockets of Punjab, farmers have to rely on tube wells, raising the input cost substantially. Punjab alone shells out a power subsidy of Rs 4500 crore per annum, putting extra burden on the state exchequer, that is reeling under a debt of more than Rs 1.25 lakh crore. (ET)

Viacom in Talks to Sell Paramount Pictures Stake to Chinese Group

Viacom Inc. executives are pressing ahead with plans to sell a stake in the Paramount Pictures movie studio despite resistance from controlling shareholder Sumner Redstone, potentially inflaming an already incendiary boardroom battle at the media giant. (WSJ)

Appeals Court Deals Blow to GM on Ignition-Switch Suits

A federal appeals court denied GM attempt to use a bankruptcy shield to block some lawsuits over faulty ignition switches, ruling the Detroit auto maker's failure to reveal the defect violated consumers' legal rights in chapter 11 court proceedings. (WSJ)

Demand for Amazon Cloud Services Holds Steady Following Brexit Vote

The UK's vote in favor of leaving the EU hasn't hurt spending for cloud services from Amazon Web Services. But the process remains in early stages, and it's possible demand could slow in the future if cautious companies defer spending. (ET)

Nokia expects boost from patent licensing pact with Samsung

Nokia expects a sales boost this year after agreeing to expand its licensing agreement with Samsung. Nokia said that the expanded agreement covers access to each other's patented technologies and will push its annual net sales in patent and brand licensing to some 950 million euros (\$1 billion) in 2016. (ET)

Airbus says output cut won't drive A380 massively into red

Airbus's decision to cut production of the world's biggest passenger jet, the A380, will not drive the programme massively into the red, the European planemaker's group CEO said. (ET)

Amazon says Prime Day orders jump 60 per cent over last year

Amazon.com Inc said customers placed 60 percent more orders worldwide on "Prime Day" shopping event on Tuesday, compared with a year earlier. The online retailer said it sold the most number of Amazon devices on a single day and Fire TV Stick was its best-selling device. (ET)
