## MARKET PREVIEW

**US:** U.S. stocks rose sharply, remaining in record territory for the fourth consecutive session, on the back of stellar quarterly results from JPMorgan Chase & Co, which kicked off the second quarter earnings season for major banks by topping analysts' earnings and revenues forecasts on Thursday.

**Asia:** Asian shares rose to eight-month highs on Friday, on track for solid weekly gains, as record highs on Wall Street offset the impact on sentiment of an attack in France that lifted the safe-haven yen.

**India:** Markets gathered pace in late trades after reports of talks between the Congress and the government fuelled hopes that the crucial Goods and Services Tax (GST) Bill is likely to be passed soon. **Market is expected to open on positive note and likely to witness up move during the day.**

**Economy:** Three Federal Reserve policymakers on Thursday expressed the view that there was no hurry to raise U.S. interest rates in the wake of the UK decision to leave the European Union, despite signs that the U.S. economy is near full employment.

The Bank of England kept interest rates unchanged on Thursday, wrong-footing many investors who had expected the first cut in more than seven years with Britain's economy reeling from last month's vote to leave the European Union. The BoE said it was likely to deliver stimulus in three weeks' time, possibly as a "package of measures," once it has assessed how the June 23 referendum decision has affected the economy, the world's fifth largest.

China will create more than 50 million new urban jobs between 2016 and 2020, the country's human resources ministry said on Thursday. In the ministry's 13th five-year plan, it said in a statement on its website that China will keep urban registered unemployment rate within 5% in the same period.

**Commodities:** Crude futures fell in early trading in Asia on Friday as concerns about a global oil glut returned to the fore and traders wait on data from China, which is expected to report its lowest growth rate since 2009. Brent crude futures were down 41 cents at \$46.96 a barrel at 0024 GMT. Gold prices dipped in Asia on Friday in cautious trade ahead of GDP and other key data from China.

**Currency:** The dollar was trading at three-week highs against the yen on Thursday as stimulus expectations continued to pressure the Japanese currency, while the pound was trading above 1.33 after the BoE left interest rates on hold in a surprise decision.

## CORPORATE

**Dishman Pharma gets EIRs for 3 sites from USFDA**

Dishman's wholly owned subsidiary Carbogen Amcis AG, Switzerland has successfully completed United States Food and Drug Administration inspection for its two sites located at Aarau and Neuland without any adverse observations. The co's site at Naroda has also completed successful USFDA inspection. (ET)

**Granules to acquire 12.5 per cent stake in USpharma**

The acquisition of the stake will enable it to participate in product selection and gain right of first refusal to market select products which are under development by USpharma, a development-stage pharmaceutical co specialising in research, development and manufacture of high entry-barrier generic pharmaceuticals, including controlled release, controlled substance and patent-challenge products. (ET)

**Bhel bags NTPC's Bangladesh project**

BHEL has bagged the engineering procurement and construction contract for 1,320 megawatt Bangladesh-India Friendship Power Company (BIFPC). BIFPC is a 50:50 joint venture floated by Bangladesh Power development Board and NTPC of India. The contract value of the project is \$ 1.49 bn which will be financed by Indian Exim Bank. The plant is expected to start generation during 2019-20. (ET)

**ONGC seeks buyers for deep-water field in KG Basin**

The co is seeking buyers for gas from a new deepwater field in the KG Basin, which will be the first to supply under the new policy that allows coS to charge a much higher rate for output from challenging fields. The gas produced from this well is currently sold at \$3.06 per unit, the government-set price available to domestic natural gas, he said. The co wants higher prices, but a global rate collapse may be a hurdle. (ET)

**Banks to assume control of two units of Amtek Auto for defaulting on bond repayment**

Lenders have agreed in principle to take control of Castex Technologies and Metalyst Forging — the two listed subsidiaries of the auto component maker. The lenders can take controlling stake by initiating strategic debt restructuring (SDR) that allows them to convert a part of debt into equity in cases where restructuring of debt has not helped in reviving the co. (ET)

**Titan to acquire 62% stake in Carat Lane for Rs 357.24 crore**

The purchase consideration required for the shares being acquired is Rs 357.24 cr. Number of shares to be acquired is 1,91,42,545 representing 62% of the company's (Carat Lane) share capital. Carat Lane is a leading brand and business in the jewellery online industry catering to a different segment of customers with significant internal capabilities in design, manufacturing, technology and e-commerce. ### CCI dismisses complaint against Coal India

CCI ruled out the charges of abuse of dominant position after finding that no entry barrier were created through the conditions in the tender, which entailed hiring technical service providers for collection, preparation and transportation of coal samples from the loading and unloading points. (ET)

### Hero MotoCorp to phase out models made under agreement with Honda

The company is looking at replacing its existing products as well as introducing new ones developed with its own technology. (ET)

### Emami to expand edible oils capacity by FY18

The co's present manufacturing capacity in edible oils is 4,000 tonnes per day (tpd) between Haldia and Andhra Pradesh plants. Post expansion, the capacity will rise to 8,000 tpd by 2018. (ET)

### ECONOMY

#### Black money row: SIT for ban on cash deals above Rs 3 lakh

The Team on black money has recommended banning cash transactions of Rs 3 lakh and above and restricting cash holding with individuals and industry to Rs 15 lakh to curb illegal wealth in the country. The SIT submitted its fifth report to the Supreme Court on methods to curb black money in the economy, an official statement said on Thursday. (ET)

#### India Inc's foreign investment down 3% to \$1.86 bn in June

Direct investments by Indian firms abroad fell by 3.2% y-on-y to \$1.86 billion in June this year, according to RBI data. Indian companies had invested \$1.92 billion in their overseas ventures in June 2015. In May 2016, Indian firms had invested \$2.69 billion as overseas investment. (ET)

#### Banks' gross NPA levels to be at 8-8.5% in FY17: Icra

Gross NPAs of banks are nearing peak levels and may be in range of 8-8.5% by March-end, domestic rating agency Icra said today. "Gross NPAs could be nearing peak levels. We project banks' gross NPAs to be in the range of 8-8.5% by March 2017," it said in a report here. Banks' gross bad loans stood at 7.7% as on March 2016. (ET)

#### Land acquisition a challenge in mineral block auctions

As the recently unveiled National Mineral Exploration Policy paves way for greater private participation in the sector, experts believe states will have to brave challenges in the form of land acquisition and insufficient expertise in conducting lease auctions. The new policy aims to accelerate exploration by getting more of the private sector and foreign direct investment. (BS)

#### GoI, ADB sign \$100-mn loan for climate project in TN

The Govt of India and the Asian Development Bank signed a \$100-million loan agreement to strengthen key irrigation and drainage system and improve water management in the Vennar sub-basin of the Cauvery delta in Tamil Nadu. The financing will be used to strengthen embankments of six major irrigation water channels in the Vennar system and rehabilitate 13 irrigation pumping schemes. (ET)

**Bayer Makes New Offer for Monsanto**

Bayer AG boosted its takeover offer for Monsanto Co. to about \$65 billion in a bid to overcome the U.S. seed company's resistance to the tie-up and join a parade of consolidation in the agriculture industry. (WSJ)

**BP Puts Tab for Gulf Disaster at \$62 Billion**

BP PLC said its costs from the deadly 2010 Gulf of Mexico oil spill would rise by an additional \$5.2 billion and ultimately cost \$61.6 billion to put one of the worst environmental disasters in U.S. history behind it. (WSJ)

**IBM Pushes Blockchain into the Supply Chain**

IBM said it has launched a platform for companies to test "blockchain" record-keeping technology in their supply chains. The service is an attempt to expand the use of blockchain beyond the financial services industry, where the technology underpins the bitcoin digital currency and is used by banks and exchanges to track financial transactions. (WSJ)

**Boeing wins orders and commitments worth \$26.8 bn at Farnborough Airshow**

Boeing said it had won orders and commitments for 182 aircraft worth a total of \$26.8 bn at list prices during the course of the Farnborough Airshow this week. The new deals included a \$1.4 bn order from TUI Group plus commitments from airlines including Xiamen Airlines and Donghai Airlines. (ET)

**ArcelorMittal purchases bonds worth \$583 million in cash**

ArcelorMittal said it has bought back in cash securities worth \$ 583.19 mn of the \$ 600 mn bonds, which are due to mature in 2020 and 2021. (ET)

**Infineon buys US chipmaker Wolfspeed**

German semi-conductors maker Infineon said it has agreed to buy US computer chip specialist Wolfspeed for \$850 mn (740 mn euros) in order to boost its position in power and radio frequency power solutions. (ET)
