

MARKET PREVIEW

US: U.S. stocks were mixed, remaining near-record territory, as considerable gains in Johnson & Johnson were offset by sharp declines in Netflix Inc shares after the global streaming film provider saw user growth fall precipitously over its previous qtr. Asia: Asian stocks stepped back early on Wednesday after a record run on Wall Street showed signs of petering out, while the dollar hovered near a four-month high against a basket of currencies following upbeat U.S. data..

India: Benchmark share indices staged a recovery in late trades to snap two-day losing streak aided by rebound in IT majors and select index heavyweights. Further, the government's plan to infuse capital in select state-owned banks also aided sentiment. The S&P BSE Sensex ended up 41 points at 27,788 and the Nifty50 ended up 20 points at 8,529.. Market is expected to open on flattish note and likely to witness range bound trading session.

Economy: U.S. housing starts rose more than expected in June as construction activity increased broadly, but downward revisions to the prior months' data pointed to a sector treading water in the Q2.Groundbreaking surged 4.8 % to a seasonally adjusted annual pace of 1.19 mn units. Starts for April and May were revised lower, taking some shine off the report. Building permits increased 1.5 % to a 1.15 mn-unit rate last month.

The U.S. Federal Reserve awarded \$82.27 billion of one-day, fixed-rate reverse repurchase agreements to 34 bidders at an interest rate of 0.25 %.

IMF slightly cut its 2016, 2017 global output growth forecasts after Brexit.Growth cut 0.1% this year and next to 3.1% and 3.4% respectively.Britain's 2017 growth cut 0.9% to 1.3%; U.S. unchanged at 2.5%.IMF said this is a "benign assessment" of impact of Brexit.But it warned full impact will play out gradually over time.

Commodities: Oil futures rose in early Asian trading on Wednesday after an industry group released weekly figures showing U.S. stockpiles fell more than expected last week.

Gold flitted between small gains and losses in Asia on Wednesday with investors on the sidelines ahead of a European Central Bank meeting on Thursday and with prospects for a U.S. rate hike sooner rather than later this year edging up.

Currency: The dollar rose to a four-month high against a basket of major currencies on Tuesday after the release of data showing U.S. housing starts rose more than expected in June, underpinning a theme of strength in the U.S. economy.

Wipro calls off agreement to acquire Viteos Group

Wipro has called off the agreement to acquire Viteos Group, a New Jersey-based back office services provider it had agreed to acquire in December last year for a consideration of \$130 million. (BS)

Gujarat State Fertilisers and Chemicals Ltd announced a price cut in 'Sardar' brand fertilisers, saying a majority of shareholders of the company are farmers about whose welfare the State-promoted company was concerned. (BL)

IMF cuts India's growth projections slightly

IMF has marginally scaled down India's economic growth projections by 0.1 percentage point to 7.4% each for the current financial year and 2017-18, due to a slower investment revival than expected earlier. (BS)

NITI Aayog calls meeting of state officials

The NITI Aayog has called a meeting of chief secretaries and planning secretaries of all states and Union territories later this month to align their respective plan process with the proposed 15-year vision document and seven-year strategic paper to be released later this year. (BS)

Panel to sort out 318 stuck mining proposals

Fearing massive litigation, the Centre has asked mineral producing states to set up a committee so that they can quickly grant mining leases for the 318 proposals stuck at various levels. These 318 cases are unique as the proposals were in process even before January 2015, when the new mining law came into effect, either with the state government or the Centre. (BS)

Offshore mineral exploration soon: Mines secretary

India would soon start offshore exploration of rare minerals and relevant rules would be in place in three months, Mines Secretary said. The government would develop exclusive economic zone for offshore exploration of minerals, including manganese, chromium, zirconium, titanium, thorium and other rare earth elements. About 50-60 blocks would be put on auction or would be allotted through a competitive bidding process, Kumar said. The blocks that have been identified are seven nautical miles from the coast. (BS)

Only 18% of India Inc ready for auditor rotation, says survey

Only 18% of Indian firms are ready for auditor rotation made compulsory under the Companies Act, 2013 said a recent survey conducted by Grant Thornton India in association with Prime Database. (BS)

More competition in power distribution soon

After rolling out the power distribution reform plan, UDAY, the NDA govt wants to open up the power distribution and transmission sector for competition. The amendments in the Electricity Act, 2003, would have enabling provisions to allow more than one player in power distribution, including private companies. (BS)

BlackBerry signs US government deals in software push

BlackBerry Ltd said it had signed a five-year, multi-million dollar deal to run emergency notifications for the US Senate, among a handful of small deals the company has signed as the company shifts its focus to software from smartphones. (ET)

Leading bidders for Yahoo Inc's core business are Verizon Communications Inc, Quicken Loans Inc founder Dan Gilbert and Vector Capital Management. Yahoo, which is in the process of auctioning off its search and advertising business, said its board had made "great progress on strategic alternatives" but did not comment further on the auction process. Monsanto says Bayer's sweetened offer inadequate

Monsanto Co said a sweetened \$125-per-share offer from German chemicals group Bayer AG was "financially inadequate and insufficient to ensure deal certainty." "Monsanto remains open to continued and constructive conversations with Bayer and other parties to assess whether a transaction that the board believes is in the best interest of Monsanto shareowners can be realized," Monsanto said. Microsoft Gets Lift From Cloud Gains

Microsoft Corp. remains a distant second to Amazon.com Inc. in cloud computing, but the software giant's latest quarterly results suggest that it is effectively managing the transition from selling software licenses to selling on-demand computing services. (WSJ)

Twitter Inc. has scored a live-streaming deal with the National Basketball Association that will for the first time broadcast original programming created exclusively for the social media company. (WSJ)
