**MARKET PREVIEW**

**US:** The U.S. market was shut yesterday.

**Asia:** Asian shares edged up on Tuesday but were mostly in a holding pattern after Monday's U.S. holiday, as investors awaited a policy decision from the Reserve Bank of Australia.

**India:** India stocks were higher after the close on Friday, as gains in the Auto, Real Estate and Green Energy sectors led shares higher. At the close in NSE, the Nifty 50 rose 0.40% to hit a new 52-week high, while the BSE Sensex 30 index added 0.38%. **Market is expected to open with gap up and likely to witness positive move during the day.**

**Economy:** New orders for U.S. factory goods recorded their largest increase in nine months in July as demand increased broadly. The trade deficit fell more than expected in July as exports rose to their highest level in 10 months, offering further evidence that economic growth picked up early in the third quarter. The unemployment rate remained unchanged at a seasonally adjusted 4.9%, from 4.9% in the preceding month. Growth in China's services sector picked up in August as new orders expanded modestly and employment stabilized, and business expectations rose to a six-month high.

The Bank of Japan will likely choose to deepen negative interest rates than expand its bond purchases if more policy easing is needed, as the cost of cutting rates is less than topping up an already huge bond-buying programme.

Greece could secure short-term debt relief measures very soon if it implements remaining reforms agreed under its bailout program, the head of the euro zone's bailout fund, the European Stability Mechanism (ESM), said.

**Commodities:** Oil prices trimmed earlier gains during North American hours on Monday, after an announcement from Saudi Arabian and Russian officials failed to live up to market expectations.

Gold gained in Asia on Tuesday as investors continued to mull the chances of a Fed rate hike this month in the wake of weaker than expected U.S. jobs data at the end of last week.

**Currency:** The dollar fell against the yen on Monday after the head of the Bank of Japan disappointed investors who had expected a clear signal that monetary policy would be eased further this month.

## CORPORATE

### Vedanta to invest Rs 3,000 crore to double copper capacity

The firm currently has a custom smelter, a refinery, phosphoric acid plant, sulphuric acid plant, copper rod plant and three captive power plants at Tuticorin (TN) as well as a refinery and two copper rod plants at Silvassa (Dadra and Nagar Haveli). It will invest Rs 2,500-3,000 crore in copper operations to double the capacity from 400 kilo tonnes at present. This will happen by 2019. (ET)

### Maruti Suzuki to launch LCV Super Carry pan-India in phases

The pan-India rollout for the LCV, which has been specifically designed keeping the latest customer trends in mind, will be done in the next financial year. A separate delivery channel will be created for it. Presently, 50 dealers will be appointed for the sales of Super Carry in five states. (ET)

### NBCC secures projects worth Rs 615 crore in August

A key project worth Rs 120 crore was signed with Archaeological Survey of India (ASI) for construction of Institute of Archeology and UNESCO category-II centre in Greater Noida. Another crucial project worth Rs 100 crore was inked with Goa Shipyard Ltd (GSL) for construction of an office building for mine counter measure vessels and an additional space in the yard of GSL. (ET)

### JLR plans to make Land Rover SUVs for Indian market

The co currently has a facility on the outskirts of Pune to assemble luxury saloons and SUVs from imported kits. A locally set up manufacturing plant will help improve the company's global footprint and efforts to take annual sales to a million units by the turn of the decade. (ET)

### Reliance Capital to expand customer base to 50 million

Embarking on a major expansion plan, the co plans to increase customer base to 50 million from 20 million along with a fivefold expansion of reach to 25,000 cities and towns over the next 3-5 years. The target includes doubling the number of its business partners to one million in this time period too. (ET)

### Aurobindo plans to launch 19 drugs in US in next 3 quarters

The launch includes products that have an addressable market of \$6.8 billion in the US. The company expects a spurt in growth in the second half of 2017-18 wrt OTC segment in the FDA regulated market too. 22 action dates through the end of the fiscal year have been targeted in this regard. (ET)

### IOC plans to double refining capacity by 2030

The co is self-sufficient in the refining segment, but keeping in view the rising demand for petroleum products in the short-term, it is aiming at a refining capacity of about 100-110 million tonnes per annum by the year 2022, and progressively scale it up to at least 150 million tonnes by the year 2030. (ET)

### DLF exits cinema business, sells 7 screens to Cinepolis for Rs 64 crore

It had earlier sold 32 screens to PVR for Rs 433 crore after the CCI gave its nod to the deal. With the closure of this transaction, the co will exit from the cinema exhibition business & shift its focus on its core assets & segments. (ET)

### ECONOMY

#### Rubber policy soon, says Sitharamans

A panel of experts had been constituted in this regard in June 2014. The report had been given but an announcement on what the government had decided, though nearly ready, kept getting postponed, she indicated. (BS)

#### Trai extends date for receiving comments on interconnect charges

Trai has extended the last date for receiving comments on its consultation paper on interconnect usage charges (IUC), from September 5 to September 26. The discussion paper has created a flutter in the telecom sector with GSM operators' body Cellular Operators' Authority of India (COAI) even calling Trai biased against incumbent players. (BS)

#### Railways has Rs 8.56 lakh-crore capital investment in pipeline

The railways was geared up to implement a medium-term capital investment plan of Rs 8.56 lakh crore, Railway Board Executive Director said. Of this, Rs 1.99 lakh crore is slated for declogging the network, Rs 1.93 lakh crore for network expansion, Rs 39,000 crore for national projects, Rs 1.27 lakh crore for safety, Rs 1.02 lakh crore for rolling stock, and Rs 1 lakh crore for station redevelopment. (BS)

#### India extends \$500-mn credit to boost defence ties

India extended a \$500 mn line of credit to Vietnam to deepen their defence cooperation and signed 12 agreements, including a deal to construct offshore patrol boats, amid China's muscle flexing in the disputed South China Sea and "emerging regional challenges". (BS)

#### Projects worth Rs 20 lakh crore set to get green light from key PMO group

The Project Monitoring Group (PMG) has cleared 276 projects and accounting for investment of nearly Rs 10 lakh crore, in the last two years. Another 258 projects, with investment of more than Rs 10 lakh crore, will be cleared soon. (ET)

**Microsoft's challenge to govt secrecy wins dozens of backers**

As Apple prepares to unveil its latest iPhone in less than a week, the South Korean electronics giant needs to reassure customers its premium handset is safe. (BS)

**Volkswagen to supply engines in exchange for Navistar stake**

VW's trucks division is close to announcing a partnership with U.S.-based rival Navistar International Corp, three sources told Reuters, in the example of a deal driven by emissions regulations. Volkswagen has agreed to supply engines to Navistar in exchange for a stake in the truckmaker. (ET)

**Marks & Spencer plans head office jobs cull as new boss seeks savings**

The co plans to cut a net 525 jobs from its London head office, as new Chief Executive Steve Rowe seeks to simplify the business and reduce costs. The clothing and food group also plans to reduce the number of roles permanently based in central London by about 400 across its IT and logistics functions. (ET)

**ABB names Nokia exec Guido Jouret first chief digital officer**

ABB has appointed Guido Jouret as its first chief digital officer, a move designed to ramp up the Swiss power and automation company's efforts in digital technology and internet. (ET)
