MARKET PREVIEW

US: U.S. stocks were lower after the close on Wednesday, as losses in the Oil & Gas, Financials and Healthcare sectors led shares lower. At the close in NYSE, the Dow Jones Industrial Average lost 0.20%, while the S&P 500 index declined 0.29%, and the NASDAQ Composite index declined 0.40%.

Asia: Asian shares fell on Thursday, reversing recent gains as investors took profits after Wall Street declined overnight, and oil prices tumbled on news of a surprising jump in U.S. government stockpiles. Japan market is shut today.

India: India stocks were lower after the close on Wednesday, as losses in the Oil & Gas, Auto and Healthcare sectors led shares lower. At the close in NSE, the Nifty 50 fell 1.19%, while the BSE Sensex 30 index fell 1.10%. **Market is expected to open on a flattish note and likely to witness range bound trading session.**

Economy: The U.S. government posted a \$113 bn budget deficit in July, a 24% drop YoY. U.S. job openings increased in June and layoffs dropped to their lowest in nearly two years as labor market conditions tightened further.

China's will further expand yuan cross-border financing and investment channels, and will further expand cross-border usage of the yuan under the current account, the central bank said.

As part of the quantitative easing measures implemented last week, the Bank of England admitted that owners of British 10-year gilt debt declined its offer to buy £1.17 (\$ 2.22 bn) of the U.K. sovereign bonds, leaving it with a £52 mn (\$68 mn) shortfall. Govt bond prices surged after the announcement, pushing yields to record lows.

The Bank Of Japan will comprehensively review its monetary policies in an attempt to achieve its 2% inflation target. A sharp fall in oil prices, prolonged hit to growth from a sales tax hike in 2014 and the country's inability to shake off its deflationary mindset were identified as the key barriers in this regard.

Commodities: Oil prices fell early on Thursday as a build in U.S. crude inventories and record Saudi Arabian production weighed on markets.

Gold eased slightly in Asia on Thursday as investors booked gains and kept an eye on dollar weakness.

Currency: The U.S. Dollar Index fell sharply on Wednesday, as the British Pound and Japanese Yen both rose steadily against the greenback, dragging the U.S. currency to a fresh 1-week low against its main rivals.

IT said the Singhbhum copper belt has unique ore characteristics which contained appreciable quantity of nickel. The company has installed and commissioned the technology to recover nickel. At present, the capacity of the plant is 50 MT per annum, considering the current production rate from the Surda mines. (MC)

Colgate-Palmolive India renews royalty agreement for 5 years

Colgate-Palmolive India's board has approved the renewal of royalty agreement with its holding firm Colgate-Palmolive Co, USA for a period of five years. (MC)

Jindal Steel and power misses \$5 mn payment, banks set to launch crackdown

JSPL Mauritius subsidiary are weighing their options after the company missed an interest payment of close to \$5 million due early August. According to senior bankers, lenders may choose to invoke corporate guarantees. The subsidiary has borrowed close to \$550 million from a consortium of 18 foreign lenders, including Standard Chartered, Barclays and Deutsche Bank. (MC)

Nod to 100% FDI in commodity broking, other financial services likely

At present, 18 areas under NBFCs are allowed to attract 100 per cent foreign investment. Foreign investment will now be able to flow into financial services such as commodity broking and other such areas not covered in the 18 areas specified for non-banking financial companies (NBFCs). (BS)

Over Rs 35,000-cr investment in Indian Railways through PPP

The investment has been committed for various projects through public-private partnership in Indian Railways. Some of the areas identified by Railways for investment through the PPP route are building last mile connectivity for ports/mines/industrial clusters, setting up of manufacturing units for rolling stock, building Private Freight Terminals, procurement of wagons, private operation of containers trains and redevelopment of stations among others (FE)

LS passes bill to provide tax incentives for garments sector

A bill to provide tax incentives to the garment sector and enable the government to raise customs duty on marble and granite from 10 to 40%. These measures will help in creating jobs and protect domestic industry from import surge. The Taxation Laws (Amendment) Bill, 2016 also seeks to expand the definition of "demerger" with a view to facilitate the splitting or reconstruction of erstwhile public sector companies. (FE)

Govt brings Bill to amend Factories Act

The government on Wednesday introduced in Parliament a Bill to amend the Factories Act, 1948, with a view to double overtime hours in an establishment with 10 or more workers, to 100 per quarter. The aim is to enhance employment opportunities and facilitate the ease of doing business. (FE)
