## MARKET PREVIEW

**US:** U.S. stocks were higher after the close on Wednesday, as gains in the Technology, Healthcare and Industrials sectors led shares higher. At the close in NYSE, the Dow Jones Industrial Average added 0.19% to hit a new all time high, while the S&P 500 index climbed 0.43%, and the NASDAQ Composite index climbed 1.06%.

**Asia:** Asian shares edged up on Thursday, bolstered by fresh record highs on Wall Street and a recovery in crude oil prices, while the dollar climbed to a six-week peak against the safe-haven yen.

**India:** India stocks were higher after the close on Wednesday, as gains in the Real Estate, Healthcare and Oil & Gas sectors led shares higher. At the close in NSE, the Nifty 50 added 0.44% to hit a new 6-months high, while the BSE Sensex 30 index added 0.46%. **Market is expected to open on a flattish note and likely to witness range bound session during the day.**

**Economy:** Mutual and exchange-traded funds in the United States took in \$19.6 bn during the week ended July 13, the most since they gathered \$21.1 bn in June 2015. U.S. housing starts rose more than expected in June as construction activity increased broadly.

UK's unemployment rate fell to 4.9% in the three months ended May 2016, down from 5.0% in April.

The European Central Bank, faced with a further slowdown in euro zone growth after Britain's vote to leave the European Union, may consider extending and expanding the scope of its asset purchase program.

Yen's recent weakening and a recently announced govt spending package could take some pressure off the Bank Of Japan as it aims to step up its stimulus program worth \$190 bn.

**Commodities:** Oil prices rose as much as 1 percent on Wednesday, lifting U.S. crude from two-month lows, after the U.S. government reported a ninth straight week of crude inventory draws, easing some concerns in a market worried about a glut.

Gold prices fell in Asia on Thursday and silver continued to drop sharply from overnight moves with attention focused on the upcoming European Central Bank policy review.

**Currency:** The dollar continued to hover near four-month highs against the other major currencies on Wednesday, as global growth concerns still weighed on market sentiment and as trading volumes were expected to remain light with no major U.S. data due throughout the day.

## CORPORATE

### AAI Indian Oil at loggerheads over induction of RIL in JV

AAI and IOC are at loggerheads over a suggestion to induct a private company into a proposed joint venture to set up fuel supply infrastructure at AAI-run airports. The AAI has named RIL as its choice and suggested to offer it a 10% stake in the proposed venture with IOC and two other state-run fuel suppliers, HPCL and BPCL. . (ET)

### Govt allows Ambuja to acquire 24% stake in holding firm

Government cleared the proposal of Ambuja Cements to acquire 24 % stake in its holding firm Holcim India, a move that will allow its parent Swiss giant LafargeHolcim to strengthen India footprint. (ET)

### Lupin launches generic oral contraceptive tablets in US

Lupin has launched its generic oral contraceptive Norgestimate and ethinyl estradiol tablets in the American market after receiving nod from the US health regulator. (ET)

### Tata Steel aims to double Indian workforce's productivity

Tata Steel Ltd plans to double the productivity of its workforce in its domestic operations in the next five years as it seeks to be more competitive. This will be achieved in various ways including a reduction in the size of the workforce through a voluntary retirement scheme which the steelmaker has put in place and a lower annual recruitment plan . (ET)

### Dabur forays into fizzy drinks with 'Real VOLO'

Dabur has forayed into fizzy drinks market with the launch of a range of fruit juice-based aerated beverages as an extension of its brand 'Real'. The new range named 'Real VOLO' will be available in two variants - Cranberry Blueberry and Grape-Blackcurrant in 250 ml cans priced at Rs 40 . (ET)

### Shree Cement to invest Rs 600 crore in Jharkhand

Shree Cement signed an agreement with the government of Jharkhand to set up a 3MT annual capacity cement grinding unit, at an investment of Rs 600 crore. The company plans to complete the project in 2 years. (ET)

### Central Bank to raise Rs 1,297 cr

Central Bank of India will raise Rs 1,297 crore by issuing preference shares to the government. The bank's capital raising committee of the board of directors will hold a meeting on Monday to "consider and approve the raising of additional equity capital," (BS)

### VRL promoters scrap regional airline plan

VRL Logistics Ltd said that they have abandoned plans to launch a regional airline saying the new civil aviation policy does not auger well for its planned venture. (BS)

## ECONOMY

### Govt against raising FDI cap in newspapers

The Centre has decided not to raise the FDI limit on newspapers and periodicals to 49% from 26%. Currently, the FDI policy permits 26% FDI in the publishing of newspapers and periodicals dealing with news and current affairs via the approval route. (BS)

### Food service sector to be key part of economy: NRAI

Sound macro-economic performance will in turn help the food services sector become a key part of the economy, NRAI said. The size of the market, organised as well as unorganised, was around Rs 3.09 lakh crore in FY16 and is projected to grow at a CAGR of 10% to reach Rs 4.98 lakh crore by FY21, it said. (BS)

### Ambuja proposal to buy 24% in Holcim gets nod

Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs paved the way for Ambuja Cements to acquire a 24% stake in its holding company, Holcim (India), a move which would lead to an outflow of Rs 3,500 crore from India and be a precursor to reverse merger through a share swap. The reverse merger was also given a go-ahead by the CCEA. (BS)

### Real estate hogs highest spend in smart city projects

The largest chunk of spend in smart city projects will be in areas related to real estate, a new study has shown. Investments in technology, which was seen as the backbone for the project, will be much lower. While the Centre has allocated close to Rs 50,000 crore for Smart City Mission, the remaining expenses have to be met by states, local municipal bodies and the private sector. (BS)

### Investors queue up to rescue highway projects

Macquarie, Brookfield and Cube Highways are among a clutch of investors that have taken up equity in 10 national highway projects worth Rs 4,150 crore from which private promoters have exited. The govt is also chalking out the entry of sovereign funds from Abu Dhabi and Qatar into such projects. (BS)

### CCI kicks off probe into rise in pulses prices

CCI has initiated an inquiry into the alleged anti-competitive practices behind the surging prices of pulses. The competition watchdog has formed an internal panel to study the market forces controlling the prices of pulses as the commodity has experienced a significant price rise in the last one year. (ET)

**US charges two HSBC executives in \$3.5 billion forex-related scheme**

Federal agents surprised an HSBC Holdings Plc executive as he prepared to fly out of New York's Kennedy airport at 7:30 pm on Tuesday, arresting him for an alleged frontrunning scheme involving a \$3.5 billion currency transaction in 2011. (ET)

**Unilever buys men's grooming brand Dollar Shave Club**

Unilever Plc said it has agreed to buy U.S.-based men's grooming brand Dollar Shave Club in a deal that would expand the consumer goods group's catalogue of personal care products. Financial terms of the deal were not disclosed. However, Fortune reported citing sources that Unilever is paying \$1 billion in cash for the Venice (ET)

**EU Approves Mylan's \$7.2 Billion Acquisition of Meda**

European Union competition regulators on Wednesday approved Dutch drugmaker Mylan NV's roughly \$7.2 billion acquisition of its Swedish rival Meda on the condition the newly-merged company sheds businesses in around a dozen European countries. (WSJ)

**Google, trying to endear itself to Europe, spreads \$450 mn around**

A fund to help European news outlets adapt to the web popped up in 2015. And in March, a virtual reality exhibition began at a Belgian museum to showcase a Renaissance painter. All these projects are aimed at supporting European culture and education, helping the region embrace the fast-changing online world. And all are financed by Google. (BS)

**Mondelez in talks to buy Cadbury biscuits license from Burton's**

Mondelez International Inc is in talks to buy the license to make Cadbury biscuits from UK-based biscuit maker Burton's Biscuits Co. Mondelez has offered to pay about 200 million pounds for the license, the news website reported (BS)

**SunEdison looking to sell interests in unit Terraform Global**

SunEdison Inc is looking to sell its interests in Terraform Global Inc, the "yieldco" said. Shares of Terraform Global, which holds renewable energy assets primarily outside the United States, were up 11.1% at \$3.61 in light premarket trading. (BS)
