This week, Bank Nifty made new record highs of 23469 and closed at 23376.

Smallcap Index this week recovered from lows of 7018 and closed at 7317, after making a high of 7332.

Nifty to open gap up by 17 points at 9662 against yesterdays close of 9645 as per SGX Nifty.

INTERNATIONAL MARKET MORNING UPDATE

In International markets, S&P500 continued to trade above its breakout level of 2401 and yesterday closed at 2437. The strength on Wall Street was seen despite a report from the Labor Department showing much weaker than expected job growth in the month of May. The report said, non-farm payroll employment rose by 138,000 jobs in May, after climbing by a downwardly revised 174,000 jobs in April.
