**MARKET PREVIEW**

**US:** U.S. equities were higher at the close on Monday, as gains in the Healthcare, Technology and Financials sectors propelled shares higher. At the close in NYSE, the Dow Jones Industrial Average added 2.08%, while the S&P 500 index gained 2.22%, and the NASDAQ Composite index climbed 2.37%.

**Asia:** Asian shares rose in early Asian trade on Tuesday ahead of the U.S. presidential election, with investor sentiment buoyed by improving prospects for Democrat Hillary Clinton to win.

**India:** Sensex and Nifty indices erased few gains but still closed 0.8% each higher, as investors turned cautious, ahead of the US Presidential Election. Sensex closed up 0.68% or 184.84 points higher at 27,458.99. Nifty rose 0.75% or 63.30 points to close at 8,497.05. Among the sectoral indices, BSE Healthcare was the top sectoral gainer up 1.9% followed by Metal, Bankex and Realty which were up 1.94%, 1.7% and 1.5%, respectively. Telecom sectoral index was the top loser, down 0.53%. **Market is expected to open on flattish note and likely to witness up move during the day..**

**Economy:** China's trade balance rose less-than-expected last month to 49.06B, from 41.99B in the preceding month. Britain will only start to lower public debt as a share of GDP at the end of the decade due to a Brexit-related hit to the economy, a think tank said.

The German banking association called for an extension to the timetable to decide on new international banking regulation. The Basel Committee of bank supervisors from nearly 30 countries intends to deliver the new Basel IV rules by the end of this year.

The European Central Bank is not considering reducing its bond-buying program known as Quantitative Easing, and is looking instead at how far to extend it after the current March 2017 deadline.

**Commodities:** Oil prices were stable early on Tuesday after posting strong gains the previous day, with investors piling money into financial markets in expectation that Democrat Hillary Clinton would win the U.S. presidential election.

Gold steadied early Tuesday along with the dollar, after dropping nearly 2% in the previous session, as uncertainty just hours ahead of the U.S. presidential election kept wary investors locked into the safe-haven commodity.

**Currency:** The dollar steadied in Asia on Tuesday, keeping gains made in the previous session on the growing prospect of a victory for U.S. Democratic presidential candidate Hillary Clinton after the FBI cleared her of any possibility of criminal charges in its latest probe.

### OVL to provide \$318 mn financing guarantee to Venezuela

ONGC Videsh Ltd will provide USD 318 million financing to help raise output at a Venezuelan oilfield after the Latin American nation signed pact to supply 17,000 barrels per day of crude oil to India to clear past dues. OVL, the overseas arm of state-owned ONGC, owns 40 per cent of Venezuela's San Cristobal oilfield and had invested about USD 190 million in the project in 2008. (FE)

L&T-MHPS Boilers Pvt Ltd has signed a technology licence agreement for selective catalytic reduction systems with Mitsubishi Hitachi Power Systems Ltd. The technology licensing agreement is for design, engineering, manufacture, installation, commissioning, and sale of new boilers under BTG, EPC or SG packages or standalone SCR systems, and for existing and under construction boilers on exclusive basis in India, a press statement said. #### All ministries to get Swachh Bharat funds in Budget 2017-18

The government plans to allocate dedicated funds to each ministry in the budget for 2017-18 as part of a big push to the Swachh Bharat Abhiyan or Clean India Mission. All government departments will have to make a special mention of Swachh Bharat Abhiyan in their budget proposals and all ministries have been asked to finalise their 'Swachhta Action Plan' for the next two years in the next four six weeks (ET)

#### Free LPG connections under Pradhan Mantri Ujjwala Yojana cross 1 cr mark; 5 cr smoke-free kitchens the target

Till November 6, PMUY connections touched 99.46 lakh and on Monday it crossed the one crore mark," said a source privy to the development. The NDA government's flagship programme aims to make 5 crore rural households smoke-free during its tenure by offering clean cooking gas, at a cost of R8,000 crore (R1,600 per household) to the exchequer. **CBS Taps Moelis, Goldman to Advise on Possible Viacom Merger**

CBS Corp. has retained banks Moelis & Co. and Goldman Sachs to advise the company on a possible merger with Viacom Inc. National Amusements Inc., which controls both Viacom and CBS. Viacom and CBS merged in 2000 and split in 2006. (BS)

**Petrobras, Bolivia to invest \$1.2B in gas exploration**

Petrobras' subsidiary in Bolivia and the country's state-run YPFB Chaco have signed a \$1.2B agreement to explore two natural gas fields with potential reserves of 4T cf. Both fields are expected to begin producing gas in 2022. (Investing)

**Zayo Group closes on \$12.8M Silicon Valley data center**

The deal for a facility in Santa Clara marks an entry into one of the company's biggest metro dark fiber footprints (1,500 route miles in the Bay Area). It's expected to contribute more than \$1M in incremental annualized adjusted EBITDA. (Investing)

**Accounting change could boost AT&T/Time Warner synergies**
